**Carlos Baldoceca Memorial Scholarship**

Up to \$1000 for programs, materials, equipment, or instruction that furthers the applicant's musical goals. The award cannot be used for high school or college tuition or fees. Carlos Baldoceca was an Oak Park resident who loved music but passed away too soon from brain tumor complications. Eligible applicants are a Chicago area residents, between 14-25 years of age and have an interested in music.

- Music lessons, camps, conservatory programs
- Instruments

**A & D Hewitt Memorial Fund Award**

\$250 and \$500 awards to encourage and enable students to explore possibilities in new and varied areas of interests, expanded cultural experiences, leadership training, and new skills development. Eligible applicants are high school Freshmen through Juniors attending area high schools.

- Examples, pre-college summer camps at universities, language study abroad, STEAM or art camps

**Laura Southwick Award**

\$500 - \$1000 awards to encourage work in the fine and applied arts. This award honors the memory of Laura Southwick who loved the arts and was an Oak Park and River Forest High School graduate in 1986. Eligible applicants are high school Freshmen through Juniors attending area high schools.

- Intermediate/advanced courses and programs in areas such as graphic and digital design, painting, sculpture, fashion, architecture, theatre, film, etc.
- Supplies to create products or productions (plays, works of art, film, audio, sculpture, fashion, architecture, technology as art, etc).

**Tibensky Family Academic Enrichment Scholarship (DUE NOVEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup>)**

Up to \$2,500 for students to experience the wide variety of academic enrichment programs offered by Oak Park and River Forest High School. *Contact Office of Student Activities to apply.*

**Tom Neumann Summer Learning Scholarship**

Up to \$6000 toward participation in an academic, cultural or travel enrichment activity between the junior and senior year of high school. Must attend OPRFHS.

**Farr Brothers Technical Scholarship (Rotary Club)**

\$1,000 technical school scholarship for person entering or completing training in the trades or vocational program (other than a four-year college) and is a resident of Oak Park or River Forest.

- Examples, learning masonry, carpentry, wood working, electrical, etc.

**Catherine Devereux Brandstrader Scholarship**

Established in memory of Catherine Devereux Brandstrader, this \$1,500 scholarship supports female high school seniors from large families who might find it difficult to manage multiple students attending college at the same time. Open to female students at OPRFHS, Fenwick and Trinity.

**Bernard "Duke" Gawne Scholarship**

The Bernard "Duke" Gawne Fund provides an annual scholarship for a graduating senior at Oak Park and River Forest High School. The \$3,000 scholarship was established in memory of Mr. Gawne, a long-time Oak Park resident whose children attended OPRFHS. Open to students at OPRFHS.

**Kiwanis Club of River Forest Oak Park Scholarship (due mid-March 1)**

The Kiwanis Club of River Forest / Oak Park will award one or more scholarships between \$500 to \$1,000 to assist high school seniors who have demonstrated exemplary efforts in community service to others, achievements in scholastics, and extra-curricular activities to attend the college of their choice.

**Rotary Club Community Service Award**

The Rotary Club Fund awards \$1,500 scholarships to graduating seniors who are residents of Oak Park or River Forest and who have participated in community service activities throughout their high school years.

**Rotary Club, Farr Brothers Scholarship (for those entering the trades)**

The Rotary Club of Oak Park-River Forest will make awards of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the post high school technical education of individuals who have participated in community service. Preference for those entering vocational or trade programs.

**Elizabeth Snow Memorial Scholarship**

The Elizabeth Snow Memorial Fund will award one \$500 each year to an OPRFHS senior planning to major in French. Students must demonstrate financial need.

**James and Yvonne Wood/Braley Family Scholarship**

Named for Mr. and Mrs. Wood, long-time community leaders, this fund awards \$2,000 scholarships to students at Oak Park and River Forest High School and Geneva High School. Students receiving the Oak Park scholarships must demonstrate financial need and have participated in community service activities throughout high school.

**William and Joyce Wartmann Scholarship Fund**

This college scholarship of \$1,000 is for graduating seniors of Oak Park and River Forest High School who active in the arts. Special consideration given to students with mid-level academic performance.
